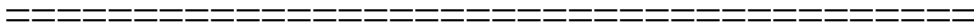


To rein in US militarism:

This is how... Email a request to your precinct chair, whether Democrat or Republican, to put a motion before the party leadership that calls for elections on this statement about federal war-making practices....

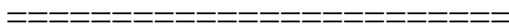
“Whereas, the United States government is supporting Ukraine in its war with Russia, with funds, equipment, and sanctions, be it

RESOLVED, That the Democratic (Republican) party of (name of) county urges the elected officials in our cities and county put this non-binding proposition on an upcoming local general election ballot:

Should the US prioritize use of diplomacy to resolve international differences and encourage Russia and Ukraine to initiate peace talks?

Once approved, party members can ask elected officials to place the question on the next local ballot. **It can be that simple!** *Approval by one's party is not needed but officials will give it more weight.* Non-binding advisory elections directed at federal officials are effective in letting voters send an unequivocal message to Washington.
